Footnotes

PINCH OF JOY was guided to the rail in the opening stages to stalk the pacesetter in hand from just out of striking distance racing to the far turn, shifted out while being roused to challenge nearing upper stretch, shifted in and out a bit under pressure racing through the stretch but wrested command in the closing stages to narrowly prevail under brisk handling. STARRY EYED KATE, reserved saving ground from well out of striking distance in the opening half, continued inside foes on the second bend, shifted out to split foes nearing the furlong marker and was going well late while closing the gap on the winner and securing the place. AUTUMN GLORY, urged clear along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace past midstretch but yielded to the top pair late when failing to sustain her momentum. NO RETREAT tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, angled out three deep after a half and continued willingly between foes to the end. JULIET TANGO, caught five wide racing to the first turn, was bumped by MARVELOUS MIA and forced wide leaving the seven furlong marker, continued to track outside foes off the second flight into the far turn, angled five wide racing through the stretch and continued with a mild bid. EMPIRE LADY angled inwards gaining a forward placing in the opening stages, stalked the pacesetter outside a rival

under some reserve, shied from the eventual winner while shifting out under pressure nearing the furlong marker and gave way. CHERRY TART, a bit slow into stride, settled off the inside to the far turn, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. THUNDERING BROOK settled outside a rival in the opening half and never gained contention. FOURTEEN DREAMS worked her way to the rail tracking off the second flight early but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. ANCIENT EYES, held up between foes racing out of striking distance in the opening half, steadily faded racing through the far turn. MARVELOUS MIA, between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, drifted out entering the turn bumping JULIET TANGO, was collected off that foe but dropped out of contention early. LAMBORGENIE trailed the field into the backstretch, was outdistanced racing into the stretch but walked off the course under her own power.
