SEE I A, on terms with his entymate from the break, attended that rival's pace under some reserve racing into the turn, moved to wrest command on his own courage after a half, then was roused to turn back a challenge from ZIGAREE leaving midstretch and edged forward nearing the wire under firm left handed pressure. The latter stalked just off the leaders outside a rival under some reserve, made a steady, three wide advance to gain striking distance entering upper stretch, drew on terms with the winner nearing midstretch but was outfinished. DOWN THE ROAD moved to the fore inside foes from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, contested the issue inside the top pair past midstretch but weakened in late stages. GETCHAMOTORROLLIN tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes just off the second flight in the opening quarter, moved to challenge four wide nearing upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. LALO'S BABY BEAR tracked just off the first flight a bit off the inside racing to the turn but came up empty when called upon racing into upper stretch. HOLY DREAMER tracked behind the second flight three wide racing into the bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. ALL TANKED UP dwelt at the start, angled to the rail while making some effort to regain contention, saved ground to upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. BRAVO WHISKEY, a bit outpaced in the opening stages despite some pressure, trailed the field to the stretch.
