Footnotes

SIN BIN, squeezed between foes at the break, was reserved well off the second flight outside a rival racing into the backstretch, made steady progress outside foes leaving the second bend, angled four wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm left handed encouragement. LOVELEIGH tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, advanced readily on the leader four deep leaving the second bend, moved to gain a clear advantage leaving the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the winner. PRIZED DANCER ducked out at the start, was settled outside foes four deep in early stages, angled to the rail on the backstretch, commenced a steady advance inside foes racing through the far turn, shifted

three wide racing through the stretch and continued with a mild bid to earn a share. ANGEL COOKIE angled to the rail in the opening stages to track just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress inside foes entering the far turn, shifted out to challenge the pacesetter between foes in upper stretch, disputed the issue inside a rival to the furlong marker but lacked the needed final bid. AVY BABY, reserved off the inside in the opening stages, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress. LIGHT MY SAPHIRE broke slowly, angled to the inside racing into the first turn, made some brief progress after a half but lacked any further closing response and finished evenly near the inside. SUPER LADYBUG was settled along the inside in the opening half, angled out racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. ARRESTED BY DUFFY was forced to steady a bit in tight quarters at the start and never mounted a serious challenge. LAST STOP sprinted to the lead along rail into the first turn, opened a commanding margin on the backstretch, held sway to upper stretch and quickly gave out once headed. ABBEY'S WISH swerved outwards at the start impeding several rivals, was righted to track just outside the pacesetter to the backstretch made a brief bid three deep between foes on the second bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. GLIDING THRU TIME stalked the pacesetter near the inside from out of striking distance racing to the far turn and emptied out after six furlongs. MOUNTAIN FELIX broke inwards, was settled between foes racing to the backstretch, couldn't produce a closing response and was gathered up racing through the stretch.
