ISTEEFAA shifted to the inside early to track just off the leaders as part of the second flight while under some reserve racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, came through inside the pacesetter to challenge when presented an opening in upper stretch, then wrested command and drew clear under firm encouragement. ABUELA EMMA broke inwards bumping MARGO'S DELIGHT, was quickly righted to secure a position just off the pacesetter stalking that foe racing into the backstretch, moved to press the issue on the far turn, lost some ground to the leaders racing into upper stretch, but continued with interest between foes to narrowly prevail for second in the closing stages. NIKALUK, prompted to secure a forward placing outside foes racing to the first turn, was rated off the leaders outside a rival in the second flight nearing the backstretch, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to prevail for a share while being just outfinished for place honors. EASTERN PRECIPICE, urged to secure the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn, shifted a bit off the inside entering upper stretch and gave way once headed by the winner. ZODIAC GIRL, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, never gained striking distance. VERY SPEIGHTSTOWN, within striking distance between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the second flight nearing the backstretch to track the leaders off the inside and never regained contention. MARGO'S DELIGHT, bumped at the start, was settled off the inside racing to the backstretch and trailed throughout.
