Footnotes

DELAGO raced unhurried tracking off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance five deep on the far turn to gain striking distance entering upper stretch, shifted in and out under pressure racing through the lane but wrested command and drew clear late under brisk handling. GAGE PARK raced unhurried behind the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted outside a tiring foe to split rivals nearing upper stretch, then shifted back to the inside racing through the stretch continuing with a steady effort to prevail for place honors. NICKELACROSS was hustled three deep into the first turn to secure the lead, angled inside dictating the pace on the backstretch, repelled a challenger leaving the far turn to maintain a clear advantage in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. MISTER THAYER, caught four deep racing into the first turn while part of the second

flight, split foes three deep on the far turn gaining some position nearing upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. MERCEDES CLASS, reserved in last off the inside racing to the backstretch, was caught five wide racing through the far turn, was fanned six wide into the stretch but continued to improve position. CATHYS BREEZE, held up out of tight quarters at the start, raced between foes in the last flight to the far turn, shifted out four wide to split foes in upper stretch and gained some position while making no impression. NO LIP, urged to secure a forward placing along the inside racing to the first turn, shifted out stalking the pacesetter on the backstretch, moved to briefly press the issue racing through the far turn but gave way abruptly nearing midstretch. YUKAN B CLASSY TOO tracked off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious bid. FOREST RUN shifted off the inside racing into the first turn to gain position between foes in the second flight, was roused to advance on the leaders on the far turn but offered no closing bid. FOX RAP angled to the inside early tracking the leaders in second flight, saved ground throughout and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SOUTHERN MUDD broke inwards, shifted three deep racing into the first turn while being steadied between foes in the second flight, continued in that path while making a brief bid racing into the far turn but gave way abruptly nearing upper stretch. JOSIES DISTRACTION, urged to a contending position while caught four wide racing into the first turn, continued in that path racing into the second bend and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
