Footnotes

GAL UMET gained a position outside foes in the second flight racing just out of striking distance for a half, commenced a steady advance on the far turn while shifting outside the leaders, switched to the four path entering upper stretch while moving to gain a clear advantage and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. DECISIVE ACTION broke readily to gain a position stalking the pacesetter a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge that foe midway through the far turn, continued three deep between foes into upper stretch but drifted out late while failing to match terms with the winner. GOTTA DANCE tracked the pace inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes just off the inside racing into upper stretch to lodge a brief bid but lacked the needed final kick. EMILY OSTROSKI was rated off the second flight along the rail racing to the backstretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. MISS THISAWAY broke sharply, dictated the pace on a clear margin along the rail to the far turn but emptied out once headed nearing upper stretch. VOL DU VENT settled well off the field racing well off the inside to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. SPIRIT OF A NATION tracked the pace three wide off the second flight in the opening stages but dropped out of contention early.
