Footnotes

BENT MISSILE broke sharply, relinquished the lead to a rival stalking just off that foe racing to the turn, moved to wrest command on the bend, forged clear racing into upper stretch and held sway on a diminishing margin to the end, feeling the effects of a strong cross wind but holding a rival safe under firm pressure. PRINCESS FREEBIE ducked outwards at the start losing some position to the field, angled to the inside racing through the backstretch, made steady progress inside foes racing through the turn, then split foes just off the inside nearing midstretch to bid inside the pacesetter in the final stages while proving only second best. REMEMBERMEALWAYS broke outwards bumping ST. LOUIS CITY, was righted while being guided to the inside to gain a position in the second flight, made some progress in that path for a half but lacked the needed final kick. KATHLEEN L tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, shifted out four deep racing through the stretch and continued evenly to late stages. ST. LOUIS CITY, bumped at the start, was righted to track outside foes in the second flight racing into the bend but never gained striking distance. TAYLER'S DESTINY was hustled to secure the lead along the inside in the opening furlong, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and gave way after a half when failing to match the winner. FEISTY FLIRT dropped out of contention early.
