Footnotes

PAPASOTE was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin to the turn, shifted a bit off the inside nearing upper stretch, turned back several challengers racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. WILD SLEW, urged along pursuing the pacesetter racing to the turn, bid between foes nearing upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. SHUE VIEW tracked the pace four deep in the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to advance while shifting into the three path nearing upper stretch, drew on terms with the leaders after a half but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. CHEROBEN tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing three deep into the turn, made some brief progress while racing in close quarters on the bend but lacked the needed closing bid. MISTER PADDY was eased back off the second flight while being guided to the inside in the opening quarter, made some brief progress racing inside foes on the turn but proved empty in the drive. SON OF PEARL was outpaced early.
