### Footnotes

MULATA, unhurried outside foes in the second flight tracking the leaders out of striking distance in the opening half, steadily drew into contention shifting out four wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to prevail in time under firm handling. COMPELLING CASE tracked the pace between foes in the second flight to the far turn, shifted out to bid three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge to the end but proved only second best. HOIST THE COLORS moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch but yielded to the top pair late. SOMALI BYRD, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. NIKALUK was urged to gain position inside foes leading the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. TONZIE, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter in the opening stages, made a brief bid between foes racing into upper stretch but quickly gave way. CHAIN OF DESTINY settled in last racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge.
