**Footnotes**

BIG MAN IN BLACK, in touch with the pacesetter while being rated just off that foe racing to the first turn, stalked the leader under rating inside a rival for a half, shifted out while steadily moving to terms with the pacesetter entering the second bend, wrested a clear advantage racing into upper stretch, drifted out under pressure through the closing stages but continued with a solid response to prove best. GAMES BEGIN, reserved outside foes in the opening stages racing well off the second flight, angled to the inside nearing the far turn, briefly awaited an opening approaching upper stretch, split foes just off the inside entering the lane and continued with interest to the end to close the gap inside the winner while proving best of the others. EIGHT GAUGE, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention splitting foes on the far turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly in that path to the end to earn a share. ROYAL CANDIDATE was urged to the lead outside foes racing to the first turn, dictated the pace along the inside to the far turn and gave way once headed by the winner racing into upper stretch. RADIANT DAY led the second flight from just out of striking distance racing off the rail to the backstretch, was urged to advance three deep between foes entering the far turn but failed to sustain that effort through the last quarter. WORK ALL WEEK, reserved while angling to the inside gaining a position in the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch but had no closing bid. SOMEWHERE IN TIME shifted outside foes early while gaining a position in the second flight, was caught four wide racing into the far turn and steadily faded from contention. SILENT BREEZE settled into stride along the inside early and never gained contention. BALLISTIC TIM, forwardly placed outside a rival tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight for a half, emptied out entering the far turn. LEAL RIDGE trailed throughout.
