DIXIE BAY lacked speed, moved closer turning for home, split horses in the stretch to get the lead then drew off in the late going. GAME PLAY was void of early speed, came eight wide into the stretch and rallied for the place while no threat to the winner. LADY SERENITY raced close up inside and lacked a winning bid. PRESIDENTIAL POWER trailed to the stretch then rallied through traffic but was too late. SEMIPHORE was close up early, dropped back on the backstretch, rallied to loom a threat in the stretch but faltered late. ADJUSTMISS was not a factor. CRIMSON NATIVE set the pace with a clear lead on the rail but tired. SPELL AGAIN was through early. GEE DON'T YOU WISH was fractious in the gate, stalked the pace and tired. FLOWER D'OR made a strong move to contention outside rivals on the backstretch but tired in the drive.
