Footnotes

PALO DURO CANYON secured the lead inside foes racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, was roused to turn back a rival racing into the stretch and maintained a narrow advantage to the end under steady pressure despite switching leads late. SICOMORO, caught in tight quarters and forced into the path of COURTESY TITLE at the start, was collected to gain a tracking position off the second flight early, angled inside a drifting rival after the opening quarter to race between foes, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and made solid progress late to secure the place. SWITCHING TO GLIDE secured terms with a rival on the lead soon after the start, attended the pace to the second bend, pressed the issue into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner late. GAGE PARK tracked just off the first flight outside a rival racing to the backstretch, couldn't make an impression on the leaders after six furlongs and continued evenly into the stretch. SPY HUNTER, reserved along the inside from well out of striking distance early, continued evenly racing into the stretch. COURTESY TITLE, bumped, then steadied in tight quarters at the start, settled into stride, then came around foes racing into the stretch to improve his placing while proving no threat. PLEASANTLYSURPRISE tracked just off the leaders along the inside racing to the far turn, but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. MASTER SERGEANT broke inwards, was settled off the inside racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. DONTA, off a step slowly, was getting out racing through the first turn, drifted out on the second bend, was soon outdistanced, then walked off the course under his own power.
