**Footnotes**

ANTHONY'S PRAYER secured a forward placing between foes in the opening stages, attended the pace in hand racing three wide into the bend, assumed command in upper stretch and extended his advantage under steady right handed pressure. RENO RIDGE was urged to the lead inside foes soon after the break, dueled for command into upper stretch couldn't match terms with the winner but held a rival for the place. ZIMANY broke sharply, tracked just off the first flight four deep under some reserve, continued under some rating while moving to striking distance four wide in upper stretch but couldn't match the top pair in the final furlong. PROSPECT ROAD, unhurried between foes in the opening stages racing out of striking distance, angled inwards entering the bend and made steady progress near the inside racing into the stretch. INEXCESSIVE SUE settled outside foes in the opening quarter, angled out five wide racing through the stretch and made some mild progress. BIG BAD MIKE worked his way to the inside early tracking just out of striking distance, made brief progress nearing upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. KATHY'S MAN settled along the inside in the opening quarter, saved ground to the lane and passed inside tiring rivals. MUST BE LUCKY joined the pace between foes soon after the start, pressed the pace into upper stretch and gave way. CHIEF CHICAGO settled along the inside and never gained contention. ANALYZER, caught five wide in the opening stages while tracking just off the leaders, continued in that path entering the turn and dropped out after a half. COURT COMPOSER never seriously menaced. LIKELY'S SUM showed little.
