**Footnotes**

CARTOUCHE tracked the leaders under light rating behind the second flight saving ground racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering the far turn commencing a steady advance, moved to challenge four deep in upper stretch and asserted himself in late stages to pull clear under firm encouragement. CROOK'S BODGIT tracked the leaders outside foes off the second flight racing three deep to the backstretch, advanced to striking distance in that path

entering the far turn, moved to wrest command between calls in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner. PRESENTS FOR BERTI moved clear while shifting nearer to the inside racing into the backstretch, held sway on a commanding advantage racing into the far turn but proved no match when confronted by the top pair entering upper stretch. BUD SYMONDS settled well off the pace along the inside racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out entering upper stretch to split rivals and made an effort to improve position between foes to late stages. TAP N POINT broke readily, was reserved between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, angled out six wide entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing. OUGHTA BE MINE reserved between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, angled out four wide entering upper stretch but offered no rally. TURNPIKE TOMMY tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid midway through the far turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. DOCTOR CAL angled to the inside early to track the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing to the far turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. CRYPTO GULCH gained a position between foes in the second flight racing just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, continued in that position to the second bend and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. SHOW YOUR FACE tracked off the second flight three deep racing to the backstretch, made some brief progress while angling out five wide racing into upper stretch but quickly came up empty. CIGAR BREAK, reserved avoiding tight quarters in the opening stages, trailed throughout.
