Footnotes

TWINE sprinted clear along the inside from the break, steadily widened his advantage racing into upper stretch and was kept to the task. BOOGIE MAN JOE tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight racing to the bend, couldn't gain striking position but continued willingly outside foes in late stages to prevail for place honors. REDBONE shied outward at the break bumping THUNDER ROW, then was bumped by KEY TO WINNING, was righted to track off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the turn, came through inside a rival in upper stretch, then continued between foes in late stages while being just outfinished for second. JESUIT WARRIOR shifted a bit off the rail tracking the pacesetter in second flight, couldn't match terms with the leader after a half and steadily faded in late stages. ITTY BITTY YANKEE broke inwards bumping THUNDER ROW, was settled outside foes collecting his stride and never menaced thereafter. KEY TO WINNING broke outwards bumping REDBONE, was righted to chase outside the pacesetter into the turn and gave way abruptly midway through the bend. THUNDER ROW, bumped from both sides at the start, settled in last and never menaced thereafter.
