Footnotes

BOBBY SANDS, within striking distance in the opening stages while angling to the rail, was reserved inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command from GO DOUG GO in time under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, bumped at the start, was quickly righted to stalk the leaders outside a rival in the second flight under rating racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to challenge the leaders while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, gained brief command racing through the stretch but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. VICTORY NOTION, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out to race between foes entering the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch to challenge four deep between foes, drew into striking distance near midstretch but finished evenly in the last furlong. DENIM moved to the fore while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, briefly resisted a rival's challenge on the far turn but gave way nearing midstretch. UNDER LIKE THUNDER broke inwards bumping GO DOUG GO, was quickly righted to gain terms with a rival on the lead racing into the first turn, attended that rival's pace for five furlongs, was urged to press the issue through the far turn and came up empty entering upper stretch. SWORD AND SHIELD settled off the second flight in the opening stages, was caught four wide racing through the far turn and dropped out entering upper stretch.
