Footnotes

BLESSED DAY, urged to gain a position outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, continued with a steady advance three deep on the bend to gain terms with the pacesetter in upper stretch, wrested command from that foe approaching the furlong marker and edged clear under brisk handling. ROAD TO WAR angled inwards to track off the second flight between foes, continued four deep on the turn and produced a solid late response to close the gap and edge a rival for place honors. WATTS FERRY broke sharply to dispute the pace four deep in the opening stages, moved clear racing into the turn while shifting nearer to the inside, briefly resisted the winner's challenge but proved no match late. SWEEPY BLUFF settled off the second flight five deep in the opening stages, made some progress to gain position racing four wide through the turn and continued in that path to late stages to improve his placing. GAVILAN settled into stride while shifting off the inside early, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. CLEW BAY settled into stride along the inside, saved ground on the turn, shifted out entering upper stretch but had no late response. DONTA, forced out by APPLESOLUTELY WILD then steadied at the start, settled outside rivals racing to the bend and came around some tiring foes racing into the stretch. WILDWOOD HEIR ducked inwards at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the bend and gave way after a half.

THEWAYITUSEDTOBE settled well off the pace, angled to the inside nearing the turn, saved ground on the bend, shifted out in upper stretch but lacked a closing response. APPLESOLUTELY WILD broke outwards impeding a rival, was righted to track between foes off the second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded racing into the stretch. LINE CAMP was a brief factor between foes but was spent after the opening furlong. COMITATUS flashed brief pace between foes but was through after the opening quarter.
