CAJUN DIABLO was urged to dispute the pace outside a rival from the break, forged clear midway through the bend, drew well clear under pressure near midstretch and was taken in hand in the final sixteenth. FEAR NOR FAVOR settled off the inside from off the second flight early, swung five wide racing into the stretch and continued with interest to prove best of the others. GREELEY'S FORTUNE tracked off the second flight unhurried in early stages, made steady progress on the bend, angled four nearing upper stretch, then continued between foes well enough to gain a share. R T'S BLACK CAT, unhurried in the opening stages while making his way nearer the inside on the turn, switched out five wide racing through the stretch and made an effort to improve his position. LOVIE BEAR angled inwards to track the leaders in second flight, advanced on the turn to challenge between foes after a half but flattened out in upper stretch. JO ALLEN'S KITTEN tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight early, advanced to challenge three deep in tandem with a rival after a half but lacked the needed final response in the last quarter. SHARP ROMA tracked the leaders along the inside from just out of striking distance racing into the bend and continued evenly into the stretch. LET'S POP THE CORK settled outside foes in the opening stages and passed some tiring rivals. BARANIT, reserved well off the inside in the opening quarter, offered no rally. THIS BUB'S FOR YOU was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the break inside the winner and gave way after three furlongs. COELLA settled between foes in early stages and lacked response after a half. JAGUAR CRAFTY trailed.
