**Footnotes**

SHARP TRICK tracked the pace unhurried between foes in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance entering the bend while shifting off the inside, angled out five wide entering upper stretch while continuing with interest, wrested command approaching the wire and narrowly prevailed in the final stages under firm encouragement. CHEROKEE WARPAIN, caught in tight quarters at the start, tracked the leaders three deep between foes from out of striking distance early, made steady progress just outside the eventual winner racing four deep leaving the turn, shifted to the inside in upper stretch, then came through close quarters three deep in late stages to edge a rival for the place. OH NO SOTO settled into stride a bit off the inside, gradually drew into contention entering upper stretch, angled to the rail approaching the furlong marker, produced a solid late response to challenge for command inside foes, was just outfinished nearing the wire, then was vanned off the course following the race. FIREMAN JERRY tracked just off the first flight racing to the turn, split foes advancing on the leaders after a half, angled out four wide racing through the stretch and was outkicked by the top trio late. BOOT TAILS was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break, lost some ground to a rival in upper stretch while shifting off the inside, then grudgingly resisted to regain the lead between calls leaving the furlong marker but emptied out approaching the wire while drifting in late. OUTLAW ZEN was urged to join the

pace four wide from the break, pressed the issue outside a rival into upper stretch, edged forward to a clear advantage leaving the furlong marker but gave out in the final sixteenth. RUNNING ON TIME tracked the pace unhurried outside foes, swung six wide racing into upper stretch, switched inside foes racing through the stretch and finished evenly. IN THE DETAILS vied three wide between foes for command racing into the turn and gave way after a half. ROCK N DIRT, caught four and five deep racing to the turn, steadily faded from contention. APACHE CREEK broke inwards, was righted to track the leaders along the inside but steadily retreated on the bend. SMOKE N ASPHALT was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing along the rail to the turn and was spent after a half. LUCKY PINS, bumped, then caught in tight quarters at the start, trailed throughout.
