PRIDEINYOUREYES stalked just off the first flight a bit off the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out to challenge three deep after a half, struck the front

in upper stretch, then continued gamely inside several rivals to just maintain his advantage in a prolonged drive. PATSY'S PROM DATE tracked just off the second flight while caught six deep in early stages, made steady progress outside foes on the bend to challenge five deep nearing upper stretch, disputed the issue outside foes to the end and just gained even terms with the leader on the wire. GOLD DE LAC tracked the leaders outside foes in second flight from just out of striking distance, made steady progress on the bend to challenge four deep between foes entering upper stretch, continued in a protracted skirmish between rivals racing to the wire and just failed to edge that top pair. JADE MAN shuffled a bit in close quarters at the start, tracked the leaders unhurried near the inside from behind the second flight, made steady progress on the bend, lacked a path from which to challenge in upper stretch, then shifted out six wide in late stages while continuing with some interest. CELTIC EXPRESS raced unhurried off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, made some progress racing four wide into upper stretch, then shifted inwards in the final furlong while continuing with a steady advance. COLE B pulled his way clear racing a bit off the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command outside a rival into upper stretch and gave way. SLOW DOWN SONES tracked off the second flight outside rivals racing into the bend and continued evenly to late stages. FLYING ACT briefly disputed the pace inside a rival racing into the turn and was through after a half. IMAGE OF SUGAR, off a step slowly, made his way to the inside racing into the turn but never gained contention. HOWARD WHO, three deep between foes in second flight racing to the turn, came up empty after a half. OUTLAW ACADEMY dropped out of contention early. SHADOW OF DREAMS was never involved.
