SCREEN SIREN, on terms with the first flight in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders to track those foes near the inside racing into the bend, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being urged to advance, took over nearing the furlong marker and drew clear under firm encouragement. NOT REPENTFUL tracked the leaders unhurried off the inside from out of striking distance early, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to prove best of the others. SONG OF MY HEART tracked just off the first flight four deep between foes in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep racing through the turn, struck the front between calls in upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. SHO BIZ SREVA, urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset, duelled for command racing through the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. LEMONDROPSPRITZER tracked just off the first flight racing five deep in the opening quarter, continued four wide on the bend while moving to striking distance after a half but flattened out in upper stretch. SOFT JAZZ was settled in last in the opening stages and never gained contention. REBA'S FANCY joined the pace three deep between foes early, pressed the issue outside a rival, then between foes racing through the turn and gave way after a half. PERFECTLYBEAUTIFUL, unhurried tracking the leaders along the inside from just out of striking distance racing to the turn, steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
