Footnotes

CAVALERO, bumped at the start, was reserved in last racing to the backstretch, gathered some momentum outside foes racing through the far turn, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to just edge ATOM SPLITTER on the wire under firm handling. The latter gained a position stalking just off the pacesetter under light rating racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to terms with the leader on the far turn, took over leaving the furlong marker and lost the nod on the wire. QUIETDETERMINATION tracked the pacesetter from within striking distance along the inside as part of the second flight in the opening half, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out three deep nearing the furlong marker and continued willingly between foes to the end to close the gap and prevail for a share. VOUCH FOR VICTORY moved to the fore a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn, resisted when challenged nearing upper stretch but weakened late. CODOY tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and continued to make mild progress between foes. UNORTHODOX, held up off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, offered no closing bid. HARVEST HOME, bumped by CANDY TRAIN and forced into the eventual winner at the start, was a bit rank between foes tracking three deep off the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued in that path into the second bend and came up empty in the drive. CANDY TRAIN swerved outwards bumping HARVEST HOME at the start, was pulling a bit in the opening stages, shifted to the inside entering the first turn, continued along the inside to the second bend, then angled out six wide in upper stretch while dropping out to last.
