ZORAN well rated, took the lead between horses then drew off when shown the whip. FRANKIE R. was void of early speed then rallied between horses and finished well. PLAY THRU stalked the pace between horses and drifted out in the stretch while tiring. Z'BULLSEYE set the pace and faltered inside. FRANK'S TIME chased the pace off the rail and dropped back. KEYSTONE KID was slow early and failed to menace. EXPECT COLONIAL saved ground and was no factor. AWKWARD MOMENT was wide in the turn and outrun. KING OF THE WIND had a wide trip and showed little.
