RIO ROYALE void of speed, advanced on the far turn, moved three wide into the stretch and managed a mild bid. JEFF THE CLOCKER was reserved and lacked a rally. SEAMANS VILLAGE forced the pace and tired. GALLOPING VICTOR saved ground and had no rally. CURIOUS GENIUS awash with sweat in the preliminaries, settled while three wide and gave no response when asked. SAWMILL ROAD chased along the inside and faded.
