### Footnotes

STIG'S DEPUTY was urged to the lead along the inside from the outset, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, shook clear nearing midstretch and was kept to firm right handed encouragement to maintain the advantage. ARTFUL BEE tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight while being urged along to maintain that position, shifted off four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to prevail for place honors. PETERS ROCK, in touch with the first flight in the opening furlong, was eased off those foes to track the pace between foes in the second flight, came through close quarters racing into upper stretch to gain position near the inside and was just outfinished for second. UNCLE JEEP was rated along the rail as part of the second flight tracking the leaders racing into the turn, was caught in tight quarters nearing upper stretch, steadied in traffic entering the lane, then shifted out to split foes in the closing stages to regain some position. MACHO JOE settled off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the turn, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and made some mild progress in that path late. SHEDROW HERO was urged to dispute the pace between foes soon after the start, forced the issue between foes into upper stretch and emptied out leaving the furlong marker. MR. FLEXIBLE joined the pace three deep soon after the break, pressed the issue in that path to upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. MILITARY LEGEND settled off the second flight racing to the turn and never gained contention. HYDRO POWER never mounted a serious challenge. STRONG LUCK broke slowly and trailed the

field throughout.
