WIN'EM ALL was urged to gain a contending position three deep in the second flight racing through the backstretch, continued in that path on the turn to upper stretch to bid for command between foes, then continued with a steady response to wrest command and edge clear late under firm left handed encouragement. CAMAGIN tracked the pacesetter four deep in the second flight racing to the turn, moved to challenge in tandem with the eventual winner racing into upper stretch but proved no match for that foe late. BEDROOM EYES, slow to gather stride, shifted out on the turn while steadily gathering momentum, angled out five wide nearing upper stretch and continued with interest in that path to late stages to edge a rival for a share on the wire. MASQUERADE FASHION tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight racing into the turn and continued evenly to late stages. COURTING DELILAH, reserved in hand early while being guided nearer to the inside, improved position racing along the rail in late stages. CHAPPY CHICK broke sharply, dictated the pace on a narrow margin near the inside racing into the turn, couldn't fend off the leaders nearing midstretch and emptied out in late stages. INDIAN ARTIFACT, caught five wide racing into the turn while well off the second flight early, never gained striking distance. PASSIONATELY SWEET tracked off the second flight racing nearest the rail in the opening stages, shifted out entering upper stretch making some contact with LITTLE MISS BE and had no late response. I WANT OUT bobbed at the start, was righted, then urged along inside foes to gain a position in the second flight, chased the leaders nearest the rail into upper stretch and faded leaving the furlong marker. LITTLE MISS BE settled between foes in the last flight racing into the turn, was bothered by a rival racing into upper stretch and had no rally. MISTY EYED tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening quarter but

steadily faded from contention racing into the turn. EILEEN EVELYN was never a factor.
