DREAMS DIE FIRST was prompted to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance for a half, steadily advanced on the pacesetter splitting rivals midway through the far turn, gained the advantage nearing midstretch and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. NORTHERN SWALLOW was rated in hand inside foes behind the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out to split foes just off the inside nearing midstretch and proved best of the others. MARGO'S DELIGHT, reserved well off the pace while being guided to the inside early, was urged to advance inside foes on the backstretch, continued to make steady progress shifting out three deep on the far turn, angled four wide racing through the stretch but continued with interest to prevail for a share. RIGHT SASSY was settled outside foes racing well off the second flight for five furlongs, angled out five wide racing through the stretch and made some belated progress. APPELLA'S WONDER tracked the leaders inside a rival in

the second flight, saved ground on the far turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch while being roused to challenge but lacked the needed final kick. RENA M was settled in last racing to the far turn and passed some tiring rivals late. COAMING settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. ABBY'S SLEW tracked just off the second flight three deep racing to the backstretch and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. MIRKA was urged to secure a forward placing in the opening stages, prompted the pacesetter racing to the far turn, drifted out nearing the quarter mile marker and quickly gave way. SAVANNAH HARBOR sped to the fore from the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin along the inside racing into the far turn, couldn't resist the winner's challenge leaving the quarter mile marker and emptied out midstretch. TIGHTROPE DANCER, caught four wide racing off the second flight to the backstretch, never mounted a serious challenge. PRETTY PENELOPE was held up off the second flight between foes in the opening stages and steadily faded from contention after a half.
