SUPERFINE TIME was unhurried early, split horses and was up in the final strides. INBETWEEN RAINBOWS was never far back, edged to the lead in the turn but weakened in the last strides. LANDERS set a pressured pace then tired late. ARIZONA ROSE was slow early, had no room inside then rallied when clear. CASE CHASER saved ground, made a bid in the turn and lacked a late response. GOLD SPIKE showed no speed and passed tiring rivals. RUNNING CLEAR raced in the second flight steadied in the stretch when she lacked room and came up empty. SILK CAT was off slowly,made a middle move while wide and faltered. HALFKARAT was forced out in the first turn and dropped back. MISS SWAIN had brief speed and gave way. .
