Footnotes

LICA'S BLUFF, reserved in last in the opening stages, gathered some momentum on the bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes three deep, angled out making some light contact with AWEEONEINTHEBUNKER entering upper stretch to challenge four deep and responded to firm left handed pressure to just prevail on the wire in a long drive. TURTLE PIE sped to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace off the inside to late stages and resisted the winner's bid to the end. MAYA'S MYSTERY, unhurried between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing the turn to gain position off the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and continued willingly inside the top pair to the end. AWEEONEINTHEBUNKER, held up off the second flight five deep early, was caught four wide nearing upper stretch while lodging a brief bid, but lacked the needed final response after being bumped by the eventual winner in upper stretch. CALL ME DUTCHESS tracked just off the pacesetter between foes in the opening stages, angled inside the leader midway through the turn but steadily faded nearing midstretch. SPOTLIGHTONME tracked the pacesetter outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, made a brief bid nearing upper stretch but emptied out near midstretch. TWO BIT BANDIT, urged along between foes in the opening stages, dropped out of contention early. POSH LADY, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, never mounted a serious challenge.
