## Footnotes

LA REINE LIONNE, forwardly placed three deep from the outset, made a steady advance in that path to challenge entering upper stretch and went clear late under firm encouragement. LONG STORY SHORT tracked the leaders between foes in second flight under some reserve, angled out four wide racing through the stretch and proved best of the others. MY SWEET REVENGE sped to the fore along the inside, set the pace along the rail racing into the far turn, couldn't fend off the winner and weakened in late stages. SEE NO STARS settled off the inside in the opening half, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and continued to make some mild progress. HELLO LOVE angled to the rail early to track the leaders in second flight, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed response when called upon. SPLASHDOWN, reserved between foes off the second flight, shifted three deep entering upper stretch and cane through close quarters while continuing evenly into the stretch. LA COLORADA was guided to the rail early, saved ground throughout but offered no closing bid. PAT PAT tracked the leaders three wide in second flight racing to the backstretch but came up empty when urged to advance entering upper stretch. VEILED FROST, held up saving ground racing tracking the leaders as part of the second flight, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch, was caught in tight quarters racing to the furlong marker and faded in late stages. BANK ON INEZ was hustled to contend while angling inwards to gain a position just outside the pacesetter racing into the first turn, pressed the issue on the far turn and emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
