**Footnotes**

LET IT RAIN bobbled, then bumped MY TAYLAUR SLEW at the start, was held up out of close quarters along the rail in the opening stages, continued under some reserve gaining position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn to advance three wide between foes, moved to command in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. MEMORY HARBOR settled along the inside while well out of striking distance early, swung outside foes leaving the midway point of the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and made solid progress to late stages to prove best of the others. PROUD OSCEOLA tracked the leaders unhurried outside a rival from behind the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes four deep and continued evenly in the final furlong while earning a share late. POCKET MISS was urged to the lead while angling over in the opening furlong, dictated the pace along the rail on a clear margin racing into the far turn, but emptied out abruptly once headed in the drive. BOM BABY, a bit unruly before the start, settled along the inside, then made an effort to improve her placing while racing in some traffic through the stretch. JO'S FINALE, held up in tight quarters in early stages, tracked off the second flight along the inside racing into the far turn but lacked the needed late response. PEOPLE SKILLS caught four wide racing into the first turn, tracked off the second flight outside a rival to the second bend and came up empty nearing upper stretch. MY TAYLAUR SLEW tracked the pacesetter a bit off the inside to the second bend, made a brief bid nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out. EL ESTRELLITA broke sharply, raced forwardly three deep between foes in the first turn, tracked the leaders in second flight to the second bend, was caught four wide racing through the far turn and gave way early.
