Footnotes

CORNEL NOBLE, forwardly placed outside foes racing to the first turn, attended a rival's pace on the backstretch, shook clear leaving the second bend and held sway on a clear margin to the end while being kept to steady pressure. FORCED ACTION shifted out early to track the leaders three deep in the second flight, angled inside foes entering the far turn to challenge inside the pacesetter in upper stretch but proved only second best. MASSECUITE, forwardly placed inside foes racing as part of the first flight in the opening stages, was eased back off the leaders entering the backstretch, shifted out nearing the far turn to lodge his bid three deep between rivals but proved no match for the top pair in the final quarter. TO THE MOON tracked off the second flight outside foes to the backstretch, made steady progress entering the second bend to bid four wide after six furlongs but was outkicked in the stretch for a share. RIVER OF NO RETURN tracked the pace unhurried between foes in the opening stages, made steady progress while angling to the inside on the far turn but had no final bid. SPARE ME TEN broke in, bumping ALLOW, was settled off the inside racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. PIANO MAGIC tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside in the opening stages and was through after a half. RULEROUS, unruly in the gate

before the start, was urged to dispute the pace between foes in the opening stages, continued to dispute the issue inside a rival racing to the far turn but gave way after six furlongs. ADRISA tracked the leaders in second flight racing to the backstretch but was spent after a half. BRISTOL BOY, reserved along the inside to the backstretch, never seriously menaced. ALLOW, bumped at the start, soon dropped out of contention, was collected by the outrider approaching the wire, then was vanned off the course after the race.
