EXPLOSIVE WAR was urged to secure the lead outside a rival from the outset, shifted to the rail after gaining the advantage, set the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch and held sway on a diminishing margin to the end under firm encouragement. HIGH'R VOLTAGE tracked off the second flight under light rating in the opening stages, moved to challenge nearest the rail entering the stretch and shifted out late while moving to close the gap nearing the wire. C. C. BANJO, reserved near the inside early, continued between foes gradually gaining contention, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch, was caught in close quarters leaving the three sixteenths marker but was going well in that path between foes late to prevail for a share. HE'S A BAD BOY settled outside foes, was fanned six wide into the stretch and continued willingly while missing for a share. DECOMMANDER was hustled to join the pace in the opening sixteenth, ceded the lead to a rival to track the pace between foes in the second flight, continued three deep between foes into the stretch but was outkicked. BOOGIE MAN JOE settled near the inside racing into the bend, altered course nearing upper stretch to race seven wide through the lane but made no impression. MOST DISTINCT was guided to the inside early, led the second flight on a narrow margin racing into the bend, shifted out in upper stretch and weakened between foes in the closing stages. RAIN RAY was urged to contend four deep in the second flight racing into the turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
