Footnotes

C'MON FEET gained a position four deep in the second flight in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance in that path on the turn to close the gap on the leader racing into upper stretch, was forced wide by that foe nearing midstretch but continued with a solid late response to prevail under firm handling. SUNNY SUPRISE, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, settled off the second flight outside foes early, was urged to advance while shifting out four deep nearing upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure to advance along the rail in the last furlong but found her best stride late to challenge inside the winner nearing the wire. NOWTHATSALADY sprinted clear of her rivals along the inside racing into the bend, shifted well off the inside racing into upper stretch, drifted out nearing the furlong marker while briefly resisting the winner's challenge but gave way late after failing to contain that foe. SIMPLY GOOD tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight early, saved ground to upper stretch and finished evenly late. MUTUALLY EXCLUSIVE settled well out of striking distance along the inside racing to the turn and never gained contention. SECOND HAND ROSY tracked the pace between foes just off the second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. MISS JOLENE was never a factor. JEWELINA ANNE was a brief factor between foes in the second flight while going a bit erratically after her rider lost his irons momentarily racing through the backstretch, drifted out nearing upper stretch and emptied out abruptly.
