KENTUCKY GAL was urged to gain a contending position in the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, made steady progress three wide on the turn to challenge racing into upper stretch, wrested command nearing the furlong marker and drew away late under firm right handed encouragement. PRETTY HEIRESS tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, shifted out to bid between rivals nearing the furlong marker and proved best of the others. SHARP TRIP was rated between foes just off the second flight in the opening quarter, shifted out three wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly late. PROPHET'S SONG broke sharply, was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the turn, gained a clear

advantage nearing the lane, briefly resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker. EVERYBODY LIES was rated between foes off the second flight in the opening stages and continued evenly into the stretch. NAUGHTY AND NICE was guided to the inside early while dropping well off the second flight, saved ground to the lane but couldn't produce a closing bid. BOB'S HILDA tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the turn, was fanned five wide entering the stretch but lacked a rally. SPACE OF TIME was never a factor while racing wide to the lane. BLOND WARRIOR hit the gate at the start, settled between foes, then raced six wide into the stretch while never menacing. U. S. S. SPENCER joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, forced the pace into the bend and emptied out after a half.
