Footnotes

SCARLET POWER was urged to gain a position off the second flight along the inside in the opening quarter, made steady progress along the rail racing through the turn to gain contention after a half, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and continued with a steady bid to wrest command and kick clear under firm handling. SHARP A tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing four deep in the opening stages, shifted inwards nearing the turn while being prompted to advance on the pacesetter, wrested command from that foe to take a clear advantage in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner while lasting for the place honors. SILKY SAMI settled last in early stages, swung out five deep on the turn while being urged to advance and continued willingly to close the gap to the end while just missing for second. A SHOT AWAY, forwardly placed three deep between foes tracking the pacesetter in the opening quarter, continued well off the rail racing into the turn and finished evenly four wide between foes in the last quarter. DISTINCTIVE REVIEW settled between foes four wide dropping off the second flight, then continued evenly three deep between foes into the stretch. COURTING DELILAH was rated between foes racing well off the second flight racing into the turn but offered no closing bid. TAP A BAY YANKEE sprinted away to a clear advantage along the inside on the backstretch, set the pace on a diminishing margin racing through the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. WESTERN CHARM broke slowly and never gained contention. MY DEAR DESERT, held up off the pace between foes in early stages, was caught four wide between foes racing into the turn and soon dropped out.
