### Footnotes

SEEKING THE HONOR was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break, shook clear entering the turn and held a clear advantage throughout while being kept to the task. GO ANGEL GO settled outside foes in the opening stages, made steady progress five wide racing into upper stretch and came around a drifting foe in the closing stages to secure the place. DEW DETIME settled between foes in the opening quarter, raced three deep on the bend, angled to the inside to bid between foes nearing midstretch, couldn't match the winner and was outfinished for the place. BETATRON, forwardly placed three wide between foes, chased the pacesetter into the turn, couldn't gain terms with that foe, then drifted out in the final sixteenth while impeding PLENTY O'JACK late. LIFE'S LESSONS was urged to contend along the inside from the break, lost ground to the leaders on the turn but continued evenly into the stretch. PLENTY O'JACK tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside, angled out in upper stretch to race four and five wide between foes, then was steadied out of tight quarters in the final sixteenth. HANGER THIRTYEIGHT tracked the pace unhurried off the second flight, angled outside foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. PIMM'S O'CLOCK broke sharply, chased the pacesetter racing four deep into the bend, couldn't gain terms with the winner, then faded in late stages while momentarily losing his path to BETATRON in the final sixteenth. MIDNITE KID never seriously menaced. LA VENGANSA briefly disputed the pace along the rail but was through after a half. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF PLENTY O'JACK LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF GO ANGEL GO. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN,

DISALLOWED THE CLAIM OF FOUL, THEN DISQUALIFIED BETATRON FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM SIXTH.
