MILWAUKEE WOLF, forwardly placed four wide stalking just off the first flight, moved between foes while shifting to the inside nearing upper stretch challenging for command, then went clear through the stretch under firm encouragement. ROCKET ZONE tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted four wide racing into the turn commencing a steady advance, continued in that path into upper stretch and proved best of the others. YES SIR OFFICER shifted out into the sixth path early racing as part of the second flight, moved to challenge four wide racing through the turn and flattened out nearing midstretch when failing to match the winner. COCKY BULL tracked off the second flight outside rivals, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but continued with a steady effort to improve position. GIRLS CHOICE settled into stride near the inside, angled out six wide racing into upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. LO ME tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight, shifted out to split foes the near the inside racing into upper stretch but had no final bid. GIBBY'S TORNADO stalked just off the first flight five deep under light reserve in the opening stages, moved to challenge

three deep between foes racing through the turn but came up empty after a half. TERRIFIC TIM hopped at the start, settled along the inside and never gained contention. RUSTY'S RED BOY was settled off the inside in early stages and never mounted a serious challenge. SPECTACULAR DEMI, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, made a brief bid in that path nearing the turn but quickly emptied out. RYANS JOY, urged to dispute the pace along the inside, emptied out early. ENERGY WARNING flashed brief pace between foes and was spent after the opening quarter.
