Footnotes

UPSELL gained a position just off the first flight along the rail racing under light rating in the opening stages, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge, took over and drew well clear under firm prompting. MY EX tracked the leaders unhurried between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, angled out five wide entering upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's kick but proved best of the others. ALL TANKED UP settled off the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the turn, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes four wide and continued with an effort to improve position while earning a share. SPECTACULAR KID tracked the leaders unhurried three deep in second flight in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. SUNSHINE EXPRESS angled inwards to force the pace between foes racing into the turn, pressed the issue into upper stretch and emptied out once headed by the winner. UNO PECADOR, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening stages, moved to press the issue in that path racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. SHIP FROM ABROAD was hustled to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
