**Footnotes**

CHIEF WANDO tracked the leaders four deep in second flight while just out of striking distance in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance four deep entering the bend to split foes challenging for command nearing upper stretch, wrested command and forged clear under steady handling. MARQUET DANCER broke outwards bumping FEAR NOR FAVOR, was urged along between foes in the second flight to gain striking distance, moved to challenge three deep between rivals nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. SHOTGUN LUKE tracked the pace five deep in second flight early, angled inwards while moving to challenge three deep on the bend, drifted well wide approaching the quarter mile marker losing some position but righted his course in upper stretch to continue well enough to prevail for a share. FEAR NOR FAVOR, bumped at the start, was righted to track off the second flight while angling to the inside nearing the turn, altered course abruptly nearing upper stretch avoiding a fallen rival and continued to improve his position to the end. AMAZING BUD, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the outset, dueled for command into the turn,

exchanged some light contact with CATCH THE TRAIN leaving the quarter mile marker and gave way nearing midstretch. FLYING ACT, slow into stride while angling nearer to the inside, never gained contention. ABACO STORM was outpaced early, continued three deep between foes on the turn and altered course avoiding several stricken rivals racing into upper stretch. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD tracked the leaders six deep in the second flight early, continued five wide on the turn while moving to contention, was steadied a bit while shifting well off the inside leaving the quarter mile marker avoiding traffic and finished the race in hand. FORCED ACTION, a bit restless in the gate, was settled outside foes racing to the turn, then was taken up nearing upper stretch when avoiding traffic. JACOBS GROUND tracked off the second flight along the inside while going a bit erratically, shifted out nearing upper stretch and was gathered up avoiding stricken foes racing through the lane. CATCH THE TRAIN went up from the break to force the pace outside a rival, dueled for command racing into the turn, exchanged some light contact leaving the quarter mile marker, fell entering upper stretch, then was vanned off the course. NO MORE TALKIN tracked the leaders along the inside in the second flight racing into the turn, fell over a stricken rival entering upper stretch and was vanned off the course. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
