Footnotes

REGAL QUEST was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing to the backstretch, switched outside that foe entering the far turn while briefly relinquishing the lead, continued with a steady response to challenge between foes racing into upper stretch and drew clear under pressure. BROKEN BOW, urged to gain terms with the first flight four wide racing into the first turn, was eased off the leaders while shifting to the inside on the backstretch, switched out to challenge three deep on the second bend, but couldn't match the winner in the final three sixteenths while proving best of the others. SIR KIPLING raced unhurried along the inside to the backstretch, was urged to advance while shifting out four wide racing through the far turn, drew into contention nearing upper stretch but finished evenly late. HEAD OF STATE, reserved between foes in the opening stages, swung out racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. SILENT BREEZE exchanged bumps with SWEET CRUDE at the start, then was steadied out of close quarters, settled along the inside to the far turn, shifted out nearing the lane and passed between tiring rivals late. PAINTED ROCK, urged to force the pace outside the eventual winner while between foes racing into the first turn, pressed the issue into the far turn, dueled inside foes on the second bend and gave out entering upper stretch. JR HILLS was never a factor. BARANIT showed little. SWEET CRUDE exchanged bumps with SILENT BREEZE at the start, was urged to gain a contending position off the first flight racing to the backstretch but emptied early. BRUISERSBOLDNIGHT flashed brief pace three deep between foes into the first turn and steadily retreated entering the second bend.
