JOHAR IRISH broke sharply to gain terms with a rival on the pace, ceded the lead to stalk that foe under light rating to the far turn, moved readily to command when given his cue entering the lane and drew away under pressure. DOCTOR TROTTER bumped at the start, was reserved in last to the backstretch, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady late response to close the gap while prevailing for place honors. SPORTING HOLIDAY, reserved between foes early, shifted out racing into the far turn while being urged to advance, angled four wide in upper stretch and continued to gain position between foes to the end while being outkicked for place honors. PERFECTLY AT HOME broke out bumping DOCTOR TROTTER, was collected to track the leaders three deep off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted in racing through the far turn to gain some position near the inside in upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. MY JOKESTER was guided inside early to track off the second flight for a half, was shuffled back avoiding a tiring foe on the far turn, then switched out to split foes three wide in upper stretch to regain some position late. CHAS THE MAN

was urged to secure the lead along the inside, set the pace on a clear margin into the far turn and emptied out leaving midstretch once headed by the winner. KID CHIC settled into stride near the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. COOL PREN angled inwards to track between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch but lacked a closing response. SIR BLUEGRASS tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. EXCHANGE LEGEND tracked the pace inside a rival in the second flight for a half and steadily faded racing through the far turn. THE FINAL MARGINS WERE PROVIDED BY EQUIBASE.
