STORMIN MONARCHO came past some traffic outside foes racing to the first turn to gain a position in the second flight, continued under patient handling to the second bend, moved to challenge three deep on the far turn when given his cue, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and drew away late under firm right handed encouragement. ULTIMO TRAGO was urged between foes to gain a position just off the pacesetter tracking that foe within striking distance for a half, gained the advantage on the far turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge racing into upper stretch but proved only second best. COLLIN'S SMILE, bumped by ULTIMO TRAGO at the start, drifted into the path of TRY A LEMON DROP in the opening stages while steadying a bit, steadily pulled his way to contention between foes in the second flight after a half, was urged to challenge racing into the stretch but continued evenly in the final stages while just edging a rival for a share. HAPPY COOPER moved to the fore while angling nearer to the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace along the inside racing into the second bend and gave way entering upper stretch. STAR OF CLASS, bumped, then squeezed back out of tight quarters at the start, settled along the inside early, shifted out on the far turn but had no closing bid. STREET SPICE, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages tracking the pacesetter, dropped back entering the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch and made a second effort under firm pressure to regain some position late. BLOTHEFELD AWAY broke slowly, raced wide to the backstretch and never menaced. TRY A LEMON DROP, bumped in the opening stages, was held up in tight quarters racing to the first turn and lacked a rally.
