Footnotes

CITY NUMBER was reserved outside foes in the opening quarter, commenced a steady advance four wide entering the turn to challenge for command in upper stretch, gained a clear advantage and held MAGIC MAN on a safe margin to the end under firm right handed pressure. The latter was settled outside foes in the last flight early, swung out five wide entering upper stretch steadily gaining contention and continued with interest to close the gap while always second best. TIGER MIKE, prominent between foes in the opening stages dictating the pace on a narrow margin, relinquished the lead nearing the turn while steadying a bit in close quarters, shifted out three deep racing into upper stretch and continued with interest between foes to make a solid second effort while prevailing for a share. ONE FOR BISCUIT was guided to the inside early, saved ground tracking the leaders to upper stretch, then shifted out in

late stages while making an effort to improve position. DOONEY ROCK, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, raced in last to the turn and made some belated progress outside foes in late stages. FOREST RUN was rated just off the first flight in the opening quarter, shifted out to bid three deep between foes racing through the turn but flattened out in upper stretch. ALREADY THERE, forwardly placed along the rail attending the pace, steadily faded racing into upper stretch. CHARBOURG, urged along four wide between foes chasing the first flight to the turn, dropped out early. TETON MOTEL, prominent outside foes in the opening stages, forced the pace three wide racing into the bend to gain the advantage after the opening quarter but emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
