Footnotes

VOUCH FOR VICTORY tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight in the opening stages, inherited the lead nearing upper stretch, made the balance of the pace under steady encouragement while holding safe challenge of THINKING OF SAL under firm handling. The latter was settled along the rail off the second flight, shifted off the inside leaving the turn, angled out three wide in upper stretch and closed the gap on the winner to the end. AF QUACK tracked the leaders inside a rival in second flight, pressed the issue inside the winner along the rail racing into upper stretch but flattened out in the closing stages. HYDROPLANE tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the bend, was fanned four wide in upper stretch but had no final bid. HONOUR THY COLE joined the pace outside a rival racing to the turn, was carried out very wide racing into upper stretch and quickly faded. RIVRAV was hustled to the lead, set the pace inside a rival racing into the turn, bore out abruptly with a quarter mile to go carrying out a rival, was soon outdistanced, then walked off the course under his own power.
