Footnotes

THUNDER QUICK broke inwards bumping STATIC KILL, was quickly righted to join the pace outside a rival racing to the bend, forged clear entering the turn to open a commanding advantage and just held ZIZI CAT under brisk handling. The latter, unhurried in early stages tracking outside the second flight, angled in entering the turn to split foes after a half and made steady progress just outside the winner to close the gap on that rival late. STATIC KILL hopped, then was bumped at the start, steadily regained contention racing into the turn, split foes near the inside entering upper stretch and was going well late. DENO'S BIRDIE chased the leaders four wide into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. FAST HUTCH, unhurried between foes in second flight early, was eased back out of close quarters entering the turn, shifted outside foes racing through the bend, was fanned five wide in upper stretch and continued evenly. STAR RATING tracked the pace between foes in second flight, angled in on the turn to make a brief bid inside foes but flattened out in upper stretch. FORTY NINE WATTS tracked the leaders three between foes while making some progress racing into the turn but steadily faded after a half. BLACKHAWK RED flashed brief pace along the inside while disputing the pace but was spent after a half. RUSTY'S RED BOY swerved in the gap at the start, was quickly righted to chase the pace along the inside racing to the turn but emptied out early. THE DEVIL'S IMAGE tracked the leaders along the inside but offered no rally. BORROWED BUCKS dropped out of contention early and was vanned off after the race. J

T'S OUTLAW was a brief factor near the inside, steadied between foes after the opening quarter and quickly retreated from contention.
