GLORY BELLE moved to gain terms with several rivals on the lead racing three deep between foes into the turn, pressed the issue in that path into upper stretch and narrowly prevailed in the closing stages under brisk handling in a prolonged drive. KATIE MURPHY, held up just off the first flight near the inside racing to the turn, shifted out after a half while awaiting an opening, came through close quarters in upper stretch to challenge five wide between foes and continued willingly to the end to just miss. TOP PAIR broke outwards bumping CHARLEY'S HOPE, was righted to gain a position in the second flight, shifted out entering the turn to advance on the leaders five deep, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to gain a share while drawing on terms with the top pair late. HOT KITTEN was urged to the fore inside foes, disputed the pace inside rival into upper stretch and weakened leaving the furlong marker. LIPSTICK LADY tracked off the second flight near the inside early, drifted out while making some progress racing through the turn, angled six wide in upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. ARMS RACE bobbled at the start, was righted to join the pace four wide racing into the turn, pressed the issue in that path into upper stretch and gave way. WILMINGTON tracked off the first flight outside rivals, was forced out by COUSIN

HALEY after the opening quarter, continued outside foes racing into the turn and finished evenly through the stretch. SHAQUITA was urged to the fore between foes from the outset, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. MAKIN SOME BUCKS settled along the inside early and never gained contention. GOT A SHOT tracked off the inside from out of striking distance racing to the bend and offered no rally. CHARLEY'S HOPE, bumped at the start, settled into stride but never menaced thereafter. COUSIN HALEY tracked off the first flight between foes, drifted out into a rival's path after the opening quarter, momentarily impeding that foe, angled to the rail entering the turn and soon dropped out.
