BRAVE YANK, forwardly placed four deep between foes tracking just off the pacesetter, made a steady advance in tandem with several foes to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, wrested command and pulled well clear under firm handling. TWYLAS RED CAT shifted off the inside gaining a position between foes off the second flight racing to the bend, split foes three wide racing through the stretch and continued to improve his placing to the end while

securing place honors. MACHO JOE hopped, then bobbed at the start, was righted to make steady progress five wide racing into the bend and continued in that path through the stretch to edge a rival for a share. OUTLAW ZEN, urged to contend between foes racing to the bend, pressed the pace into upper stretch and gave way. VICE LORD was settled outside foes early, raced four wide through the turn and continued evenly to late stages. THE REAL CHAS, bumped at the start, was settled off the inside racing to the bend and made some belated progress between foes along the inside racing through the stretch. R RICH E. RICH broke inwards bumping THE REAL CHAS, was righted to gain brief contention between foes racing to the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. CITY NUMBER was settled out of striking distance racing three deep between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. LUMPSINMYOATMEAL, prominent five wide in the opening stages, tracked just off the first flight racing four wide into the turn and dropped out in upper stretch. SABAGO was never a factor. PALACE TENOR shifted to the inside early tracking off the second flight, saved ground on the bend and steadily faded. JOHNNIES BREEZE, urged to secure the lead while shifting to the inside, set the pace into the turn and emptied out before a half.
