Footnotes

PROUD MCKEE, forwardly placed between foes near the inside in the opening stages, was eased off the pace nearing the turn while continuing in hand, shifted off the inside splitting foes on the turn, angled four wide entering upper stretch while readily gaining terms with the first flight, then took over and went well clear under steady pressure late. BLYDE RIVER BOY, in close attendance to the pace between foes in the opening stages, angled to the inside stalking just off the leaders racing into the turn, shifted out three wide to challenge for command between foes in upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner. BONDSTEEL settled between foes well out of striking distance early, split foes racing into upper stretch and produced his best stride late to gain a share racing three deep between rivals. NAFIR'S LAD, prominent five wide between foes in the opening stages, angled inwards while continuing with a steady bid racing into the bend, gained brief command in upper stretch but faltered leaving the furlong marker. N. Y. WISE GUY broke outwards bumping AMERIHEART, raced under reserve off the second flight, angled to the inside on the turn to challenge inside the leaders in upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. LITTLEBROWNROAD settled outside foes in the opening stages, made some progress racing five wide on the turn and continued to improve

position outside foes to late stages. ICANDAZZLE was hustled to the lead between foes, set the pace on the rail racing through the turn and emptied out in upper stretch. DOUGHNUT MAN was urged to contend along the rail but gave way early. FORTUNATE JONES was urged to contend four wide between foes racing into the turn but steadily retreated after three furlongs. RUSTIC WAGON broke awkwardly and never gained contention. ZAGOMOR, caught six wide racing into the turn, steadily faded nearing upper stretch. AMERIHEART hopped, then was bumped at the start and soon trailed.
