Footnotes

NO GOOD DEED was rated just off the first flight in the opening stages, made a steady four wide advance on the turn to gain striking position entering upper stretch, bid for command outside foes and responded to strong handling to narrowly prevail in time. KIND REGARDS, urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the bend, lost some position to the pacesetter midway through the bend, but continued with a solid second effort inside that foe to dispute the issue to late stages while prevailing for place honors. SILVER CRAFT, on terms with the first flight four deep attending the pace under light rating in the opening quarter, moved to gain a clear advantage on the turn while shifting nearer to the inside, resisted when challenged by the top pair leaving midstretch and just yielded in the final strides. STAR OF PARADISE was settled just out of striking distance while angling inwards a bit, shifted out four deep leaving the bend to split foes and continued with an effort to improve position. RETAP broke slowly, settled into stride, angled out five wide racing into the stretch to gain some position but made no real impression. PETERS ROCK ducked out at the start, was quickly righted to gain terms with the first flight between foes attending the pace, was urged to maintain that position racing into the bend but steadily faded after a half. WHAT DO YOU MEAN joined the pace from the outset racing three deep between foes, pressed the issue in that path racing into the turn and gave way after a half.
